



**NOTICE OF REGATTA SERIES  
2.4 Meter CanAm Championship Series  
Open Event  
United States 2.4mR Class Association  
Port Charlotte, Florida USA**

**January - April 2021**

**The Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club requests that all participants to wear masks or face coverings when Social Distancing (6 feet/2meters) is not possible on the Club grounds. Additional requirements may be necessary to remain in compliance with Federal/State and local guidelines.**

**The CHYC facility and Dockmaster's building is disinfected daily with Clean O Zone.**

**1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY**

The US 2.4mR Class Association, and hosting by the Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club (CHYC), and the Charlotte Harbor Youth Sailing (CHYS).

**2. RULES**

- 2.1 The series will be governed by the *rules* as defined with in the current *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 2.2 This is an "Open Event". Boats are to be sailed under the 2.4mR design rule and is open for sailors with and without physical disabilities.
- 2.3 Only boats that meet the requirements of the NMKIII One Design rule can qualify for series overall trophies.
- 2.4 For the purpose of CanAm Championship Series scoring, place scores from each individual regatta will be counted relative to only other registered CanAm Series participants. A boat that has entered the CanAm Series, but did not start, did not finish, retired, or was disqualified in an individual regatta shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered in the CanAm Series that registered and checked-in for that individual regatta.
- 2.5 Sail number change(s) after the close of registration must be submitted to the PRO in writing and must be approved prior to the use of the number(s) be allowed.
- 2.6 Where the Notice of Race conflicts with the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing instructions shall apply.
- 2.7 Boat storage for CanAm competitors will be provided from Jan 1<sup>st</sup> through April 31, 2021.

2.8 The Series NOR is for all regattas listed in 3.1 Sailing Instructions will be provided for each regatta. If there is a conflict between the Series NOR and the individual regatta Sailing Instructions, the SIs shall prevail.

2.9 Bow numbers may be assigned to CanAm Series participants first, and then following participants for an individual regatta.

4.3 A boat is not registered until its regatta fee is paid and proof of insurance is confirmed.

### 5. REQUIRED FEES

5.1 Series Entry Fees: \$400.00USD – rigged storage included for the Series.

5.2 Entry Fees for a single 2-day regatta is \$100.00 USD and single 3-day is \$140.00 USD

5.3 Storage is included with Series registration. Non-Series regatta additional rigged storage for non-Series competitor's is \$30.00 USD per month between Jan. 1st, 2021 - April 31, 2021. This fee is paid directly to CHYC.

5.4 Payment of all fees are preferred through registration links in 4.2.

Payment may also be made in U.S. Dollars, or Checks drawn on a U.S. bank.

6.4 Launching will be allowed 2 days prior to and 1 day following each series regatta.

## **7. EQUIPMENT AND MEASUREMENT CHECKS**

7.1 Measurement checks and inspections may be made at any time at the discretion and direction of the Race Committee.

7.2 The following items will be checked for compliance; towline, installed manual pump.

7.3 Personal flotation devices, PFDs, must be worn from dock to dock except for brief periods to adjust clothing. For contestants from the United States, the PFD shall be Coast Guard approved. Foreign competitors shall wear PFDs that are Coast Guard approved or PFDs approved by their sponsoring countries.

## **8. VENUE**

CanAm events will be in Charlotte Harbor, immediately south of Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club entrance channel.

## **9. The Courses**

The courses will be windward-leeward or a double windward-leeward with a race duration of approximately 45 to 90 minutes.

## **10. SCORING**

- 10.1 For each individual regatta, the Low Point Scoring System in the current The Racing Rules of Sailing will apply.
- 10.2 When six races are completed in an individual 2-day regatta there will be one score excluded.
- 10.3 When seven or more races are completed in an individual 3-day regatta there will be one score excluded.
- 10.4 For the purpose of CanAm Championship Series scoring, place scores from each individual regatta will be counted relative to only other registered CanAm Series participants. A boat that has entered the CanAm Series, but did not start, did not finish, retired or was disqualified in an individual regatta shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats entered in the CanAm Series that registered and checked-in for that individual regatta.
- 10.5 The 5 regattas of 3.1 above will constitute the CanAm Series. Place scores from each individual Regatta will be used in a low point scoring system (1<sup>st</sup> place= 1 point, 2<sup>nd</sup> place = 2 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place = 3 points, etc) the boat with the lowest score will be declared the CanAm series winner. For the purpose of CanAm series scoring, place scores from each regatta will be counted relative to other CanAm participants.
- 10.6 When fewer than 5 regattas have been completed, a boat's CanAm score will be the total of all her individual regatta finishing positions. When 5 regattas have been completed, a boat's CanAm score will be the total of her regatta finishing positions, excluding her worst. **US Nationals CanAm Finale #5 may not be dropped.**

## **11. COMMUNICATION AND SUPPORT BOATS**

- 11.1 VHF radios are permitted.
- 11.2 Competitor support boats are allowed and shall be marked with a white flag 1ft x 1ft on a staff. Support boats shall check-in during registration times as described in NOR 6.1

## **12. BERTHING AND HAULOUT RESTRICTIONS**

There will be no haul out restrictions. Floating docks berthing is a priority for sailor's with disabilities. AB sailors may use fixed docking and may use floating docks after all sailor's with disabilities have docked if space is available. Support boats must arrange fixed docking with the CHYC Dock Master prior to each regatta.

## **13. PRIZES**

Prizes will be given to the top three overall finishers of each regatta and the top three overall finishers at the end of the Series.

- 13.1 **Only boats that meet the requirements of the NMKIII One Design rule can qualify for series overall trophies.**

## **14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to or during, or after the regatta.

## 15. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of US\$300,000 per occurrence or the equivalent.
